
# Benefits at a Glance

### Here are highlights of the benefits that are available

#### Medical

The Fund offers a comprehensive medical plan to provide important protection in the event of illness or injury. Your Blue Cross Blue Shield of Arizona (BCBSAZ) PPO plan gives you the advantages of a national network with the option to visit an out-of-network provider. You don't need to select a primary care provider (PCP) or get referrals to see specialists. You'll also save more if you use an in-network provider. Visit azblue.com for more information.

#### Telehealth



Telehealth can be a cost-effective alternative to expensive emergency room or urgent care visits. You can schedule virtual visits with a

doctor, counselor, or psychiatrist through BCBSAZ BlueCare Anywhere. Virtual visits are available 24/7 and can occur anywhere you have access to the internet, on your computer, tablet, or mobile device. When you access telehealth, there is only a \$10 copay (less than an office visit). Visit BlueCareAnywhereAz.com for more information.

### Prescription drugs




Prescription drug coverage is included with your medical plan coverage and is offered through MedImpact. Your options include:

- >> Retail includes access to more than 67,000 participating pharmacies, including chains such as CVS, Safeway, and Walgreens
- Specialty Rx provides support services for complex therapies
- ≫ Mail Order can send maintenance medications (30- to 90-day supply) directly to your home

#### Dental



- >>> Preventive services, including exams, cleanings, consultations, fluoride, X-rays, etc.
- >> Basic services, including fillings, sealants, stainless steel crowns, root canals, treatments of gum disease, and oral surgery
- Major services, including prosthodontics, bridge or denture repair, implants, and restorative crowns

You can maximize your benefit savings when you visit an in-network PPO or Premier contracted dental provider.

#### Vision



Vision benefits are provided through VSP (Vision Service Plan). Vision benefits

### Life and AD&D

The Fund provides basic life insurance coverage for you, your spouse, and your dependent children. Basic life insurance pays a benefit in the event of the insured's death during a specified term.

The Fund also provides accidental death and dismemberment (AD&D) insurance coverage for you. AD&D pays benefits to your beneficiary if the cause of death is an accident. (Dependents are not eligible for AD&D insurance coverage.) To make sure your beneficiaries are current or for more information, visit zenith-american.com.

### Short-term disability

The loss of income due to disability (including pregnancy) can cause serious financial hardship for your family. Short-term disability insurance replaces a portion of your income and can help you continue to meet your financial obligations. The Fund pays the cost of this coverage, and it is available to Plan A and Plan B participants. Visit zenith-american.com for more information.

### Defined Benefit (pension) plan

The Fund established a pension plan as a way for working employees to accumulate money in the event of disability or death and to provide another means of financial security at retirement. Your employer contributes to the pension plan on your behalf while you are working in covered employment. The pension plan provides a fixed monthly amount to you when you retire (or become disabled) and provides for spousal benefits in the event of your death. Participants have access to a pension under the IBEW 640 Plan as well as the National Pension Plan. Visit zenith-american.com for more information.

## Defined Contribution (401k) plan

The Fund also provides a 401(k) plan as part of your retirement benefits. Unlike the pension plan, you can make contributions to this account to supplement the employer contributions made on your behalf. You can choose how much of your eligible pay you'd like to contribute and how to invest the money. And you will not be taxed until you withdraw the money at retirement. Saving for your retirement is important. Both of these retirement plans together will provide you with a meaningful retirement.

### Online courses through Vubiz

You (and your family members) have access to a library of courses 24 hours a day, seven days a week through Vubiz. You can take courses on topics such as Time Management, Back Safety, and Basic Finance. There are also vuKidz courses for your younger family members. To view a list of courses, visit ibewus.vubizlearning.com.

The first time you sign on, click on the bottom left where it says First Time User?, and complete the six questions that will allow us to print certificates with your name on them and recognize you when you return to take more courses. Under Name, be sure to enter your first and last names, for example: John Smith. Please use the drop-down menu to click on your Local # 640/AZNECA. If you don't know your membership number, you can use any numeric, such as your phone number; please do not use spaces.
